

# PRINTABLE PREPOSITION GAME CARD PACK

Fun, hands-on grammar play

## HOW TO USE THESE CARDS

This printable includes 4 types of cards:

- Character Nouns (Who is doing the action?)
- Verbs (What are they doing?)
- Prepositions (Where or how?)
- Object Nouns (What are they interacting with?)

Each set is a different color for easy sorting.

Print, cut, and laminate for durability if desired.

### Game 1: Build-a-Silly-Sentence

1. Draw 1 card from each category.
2. Create a complete sentence using the cards  
*Example: The hamster dances under the trampoline.*
3. Say it, draw it, or act it out!
4. Optional: Trade one card or add one for a challenge.

### Game 2: Draw It!

1. Draw a set of cards and illustrate the sentence.
2. Share your drawing and sentence — or take turns guessing what it was!

### Game 3: Find the Phrase (Extension for Older Kids)

1. Build a sentence using 1 card from each category.
2. Identify the complete prepositional phrase in the sentence.
3. Underline or say the preposition and the object of the preposition.

 *Example: The knight tiptoed behind the jellybean.*

Preposition = behind

Object of the preposition = jellybean

Prepositional phrase = behind the jellybean

Each card set includes 2 blank cards so you can personalize your game.

Here are a few fun ideas:

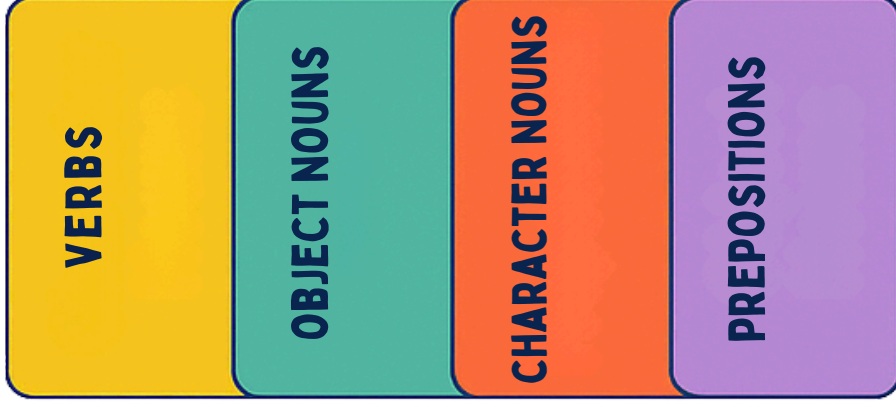
Add your pet's name to a Character Noun card
